## Staffers from State Senator Lakesia Collins's Office Visit the Seton Soup Kitchen

CHICAGO: On Wednesday and Thursday, May 17 and 18, staffers from the office of State Senator Lakesia Collins volunteered in our kitchen. They made chicken stew with vegetables and pasta -- a favorite among our guests -- and we have plenty of it!

Senator Collins is a Chicago native with a nursing background. Addressing the needs of others is part of her DNA. She was instrumental in passing groundbreaking nursing home reform in 2010; she was the co-founder of Intergen Alliance, a coalition of seniors and young activists to work on issues like healthcare, voting rights, and tuition free colleges; she also facilitates racial justice workshops for community and labor groups; and she received the Florence Criley Award from the Coalition of Labor Women for her activism and leadership inspiring young women to take on leadership roles.
